

# Efforts to deliver aid routes into Gaza

Airdrops of food, a new sea route, and trucks entering through border crossings have not yet delivered enough food and supplies to Gaza to meet the needs of an increasingly desperate and hungry population



## SEA ROUTE

On Mar 16, Spanish ship **Open Arms** delivers 200 tonnes of food

provided by U.S. charity **World Central Kitchen**, as part of European and Emirati efforts to open maritime corridor from Cyprus

U.S. Navy logistics support vessel **General Frank S. Besson** tasked with building floating dock and pier, to enable 2 million meals per day into Gaza



## AIR ROUTE

U.S., Jordan, France and others have conducted airdrops of aid in Gaza



## LAND ROUTE

Lorries entering south of Gaza through Egyptian-controlled

**Rafah Crossing** and Israeli-controlled **Kerem Shalom Crossing**. But trucks face arduous process that can take three weeks
