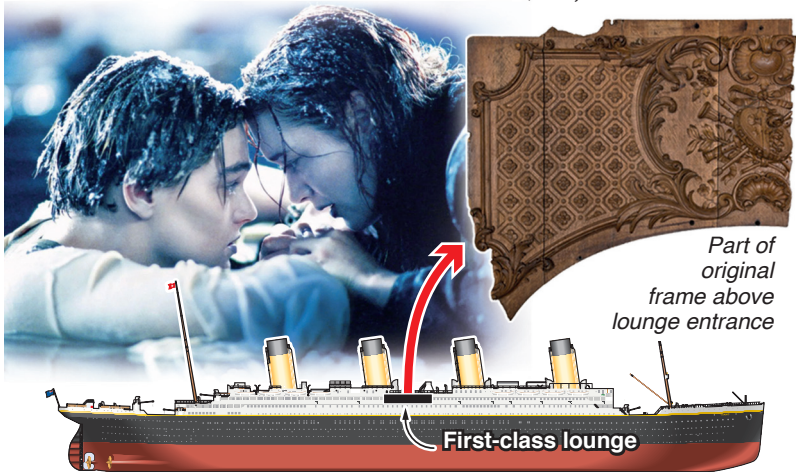


Titanic “door” prop fetches huge sum

The controversial “door” that saved Rose – but sadly not Jack – in James Cameron’s *Titanic* has sold for \$718,750 at auction

Prop: Often mistaken for door, panel is inspired by most complete piece of debris salvaged from shipwreck

RMS Titanic: Luxury liner hit iceberg on maiden voyage on Apr 14, 1912

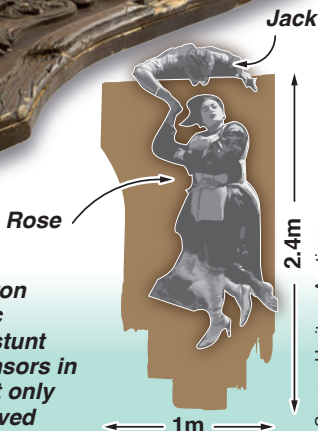
Prop sells for \$718,750
