

ICJ to rule on German military aid to Israel

Germany will face accusations of “facilitating” acts of genocide and breaches of international law in supplying arms to Israel, which denies its military campaign in Gaza contravenes the Genocide Convention

Germany 29.7%

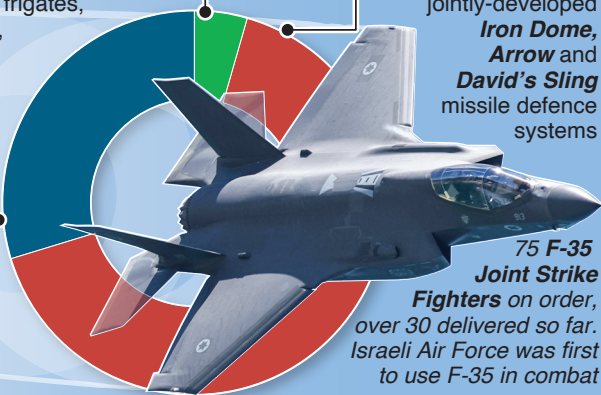
Worth \$326m in 2023, 10 times the amount for 2022, majority after Oct 7. **MEKO** frigates, **Dakar** submarines, components for air defence and communications

Italy 4.7%

Worth just \$14.8m, 0.9%, in 2023. Helicopters, naval artillery

U.S. 65.6%

\$3.8bn annually in grants, including \$500m to fund jointly-developed **Iron Dome**, **Arrow** and **David's Sling** missile defence systems



75 F-35 Joint Strike Fighters on order, over 30 delivered so far. Israeli Air Force was first to use F-35 in combat

UK \$53m in 2022, \$727m in export licences for components since 2008

Canada \$15.7m in 2022. New permits suspended to confirm use meets Canadian legal requirements
