Approval by the U.S. House of Representatives of a \$61 billion package for Ukraine puts the country a step closer to receiving an infusion of new firepower to fight Russian attacks

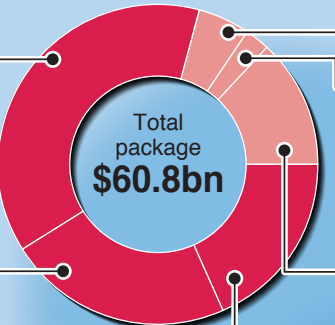
