▲ **Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis, a global symbol of jet-set glamour as the wife of President John F. Kennedy and then Greek tycoon Aristotle Onassis, died at age 64**

1802: Napoleon Bonaparte created the Legion d'Honneur, the highest decoration in France

1845: The ill-fated expedition of John Franklin set sail from London to find the Northwest Passage

1999: After months of hype, the movie Star Wars Episode 1: The Phantom Menace took \$28.5m on its first day
