1934: The Dionne sisters, the first surviving set of quintuplets, were born in Ontario, Canada

1964: The first National Covenant of the Palestine Liberation Organization was drafted in Jerusalem

1999: Leonardo da Vinci's fresco of the Last Supper went on public display in Milan for the first time in 20 years

2008: A 380m-year-old fossil fish provided the oldest-known example of a mother giving birth to live young
