

# Gaza's humanitarian catastrophe

Gaza is suffering an unfolding humanitarian crisis, nearly seven months after Israel launched a devastating offensive in response to the Oct 7 Hamas-led attacks that killed 1,200 people in Israel

■ **HOMES:** 1.7 million, more than 75% of Gaza's population, left homeless, says UNRWA†. Around 62% of all homes – 290,820 housing units – damaged or destroyed, according to World Bank

■ **HEALTH:** Only 10 of Gaza's 36 hospitals partially functioning, WHO estimates. Eight of 24 UNRWA health centres operational

■ **FAMINE:** 1.1 million people suffering catastrophic levels of hunger. 16-25% of children aged 6-59 months have acute malnutrition in northern Gaza

■ **HUMANITARIAN AID:** Aid agencies continue to face denials of planned missions, or prolonged delays at Israeli checkpoints
