June 6, 1944

▲ **Allied forces landed on the beaches of Normandy, France. Operation Overlord, codenamed D-Day, was the largest seaborne invasion in history**

1984: Tetris, one of the best-selling video games of all time, was released

2004: Israeli Premier Ariel Sharon won approval for a plan to withdraw Jewish settlements in Gaza

2004: Tamil, one of 22 official languages in India, was the first to be given the status of a “classical language”

2023: The Nova Kakhovka dam in Russian-occupied Ukraine was destroyed, releasing a huge amount of water down the Dnipro River
