*June 7, 1848*

▲ Paul Gauguin, the French post-impressionist painter greatly influenced by Van Gogh, was born. His work was not fully appreciated until after his death

**1494:** Spain and Portugal signed the Treaty of Tordesillas, agreeing to divide the New World between themselves

**1929:** The Vatican State was established in Rome

**1981:** Israeli warplanes destroyed the Osirak reactor in Iraq to prevent the manufacture of nuclear weapons

**2023:** Millions of people in the U.S. and Canada were warned to limit time outdoors due to smoke and bad air quality from large wildfires
