1954: An aerial search party found over 100,000 people isolated from the world in the highlands of Papua New Guinea

1971: The United States formally ended its 20-year-old embargo on trade with China

1999: NATO suspended its bombing campaign against Yugoslavia after Serbia agreed to withdraw troops from Kosovo
