▲ Russia's mercenary Wagner Group seized the city of Rostov on Don and sent an armoured convoy towards Moscow, but the revolt was called off within hours

1994: One of the world's largest cargo aircraft, the Beluga, was unveiled

1998: Feathered dinosaur fossils found in China supported the theory that birds descended from dinosaurs

1999: The U.S. offered a \$5m reward for information leading to the arrest of Serb president Slobodan Milosevic and four others indicted for war crimes

2009: A flute carved over 35,000 years ago, possibly the world's oldest musical instrument, was discovered
