

# Israeli war cabinet members quit

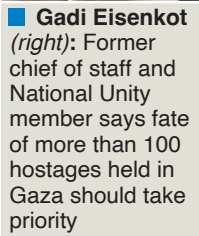
War council ministers Benny Gantz, Gadi Eisenkot and Chili Tropper resigned from Benjamin Netanyahu's emergency government on Sunday, laying bare deep divisions over the Gaza war

■ **Benny Gantz** (right): Former military chief, defence minister and leader of centrist **National Unity** political alliance, Gantz warned he would quit government unless clear post-war strategy for Gaza was made. Gantz leads Netanyahu in opinion polls



■ **Gadi Eisenkot** (right): Former chief of staff and National Unity member says fate of more than 100 hostages held in Gaza should take priority



■ **Yoav Gallan** (left): Defence minister publicly challenged Netanyahu for clear "day after" strategy in Gaza



■ **Chili Tropper** (left): Minister-without-portfolio, third member of National Unity and member of war cabinet, also quit government



■ **Itamar Ben-Gvir** (right): National security minister and leader of far-right **Jewish Power** party has demanded Gantz's vacant seat in war cabinet
