July 9, 1877

▲ The first ever lawn tennis championship was played at Wimbledon. The men's singles game was won by rackets player Spencer Gore

1993: Canada passed the Nunavut Act. It led to the creation in 1999 of Nunavut, Canada's largest territory

2004: The International Court of Justice ruled that Israel's West Bank security barrier violated international law

2004: A U.S. Senate Committee reported that false and misleading information preceded the 2003 invasion of Iraq

2022: Protesters in Sri Lanka stormed the President's Palace, forcing President Gotabaya Rajapaksa to flee
