▲ **A cave rescue in Thailand successfully extracted 12 boys and their soccer coach, trapped for 17 days after heavy rains flooded narrow passages**

1962: Volvo engineer Nils Bohlin patented the three-point car seat belt, which has saved many lives

2007: Canada increased its military presence in the Arctic to protect its interests in the Northwest Passage

2008: Apple launched its iPhone App Store, with 500 apps available. As of 2022, it offered more than 1.6 million

2023: The Cerberus heatwave began in southern Europe, with temperatures of up to 46°C (115°F) recorded
