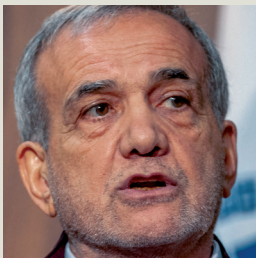


Iran heads to presidential run-off

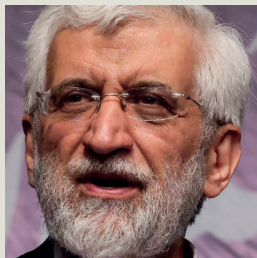
