

# U.S. fears political violence

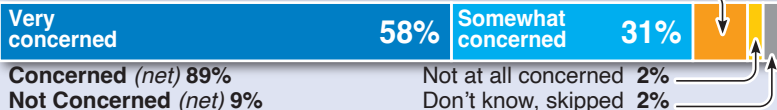
Four in every five American voters feel the U.S. is spiraling out of control after the attempted assassination of former President Trump, a Reuters-Ipsos poll has found



▲ **Jul 13, 2024:** **Donald Trump** narrowly avoids death when would-be assassin's bullet grazes his ear at campaign rally in Pennsylvania

▲ **Jan 6, 2021:** Thousands of Trump supporters attack U.S. Capitol in bid to overturn Trump's election loss to **Joe Biden**. Five people killed
