*August 14, 2018*

▲ A 200m section of a motorway bridge collapsed in Genoa, Italy, plunging vehicles on to rail tracks and warehouses below. Over 40 people were killed

**1969:** British troops were deployed in Northern Ireland in a bid to quell sectarian violence

**1974:** Fighting resumed in Cyprus after peace talks broke down over a Turkish demand for autonomous regions

**2015:** The U.S. flag was raised at the newly reopened embassy in Cuba

**2023:** An Atlanta grand jury indicted former U.S. President Donald Trump for scheming to overturn his 2020 election loss in Georgia
