

Israel vows response to Golan attack

Lebanon is on high alert after Israel vowed a “harsh response” to the rocket strike on Majdal Shams, a Druze town in Israeli-occupied Golan. Hezbollah said it had fired rockets in the area but denied responsibility

WHO ARE THE DRUZE?



- ▶ Ethnoreligious group of around 1 million, in Lebanon, Syria, Jordan and around 150,000 in Israel
- ▶ Druze recognise State of Israel and have served in IDF since 1957
- ▶ Of 21,000 in Golan Heights – occupied in 1967 – around 80% still identify as Syrian
