▲ Mexican artist Jose Clemente Orozco died. One of the greatest mural painters of the 20th century, his works adorn many buildings in Mexico and the United States

1914: James Alfred Van Allen, U.S. physicist who discovered the two zones of radiation encircling the earth to which he gave his name, was born

1994: The U.S. Army formally left Berlin, ending the U.S. presence there after nearly 50 years

2009: Drivers in Samoa switched to driving on the left hand side of the road

2023: Storm Daniel unleashed four days of cataclysmic rain in central Greece, causing major damage
