▲ Italian film star Sophia Loren was born. Her Best Actress Oscar, for the 1961 film *Two Women*, was the first won by any artist for a foreign-language performance

**1859:** The first electric stove was patented in the United States. Prior to that wood, coal, or gas was used

**1949:** The first government of the Federal Republic of Germany was announced
