Pope Francis takes the longest tour of his 11-year papacy, visiting four island nations in an ambitious trip that will test the strength of the 87-year-old Catholic Church leader



ITINERARY

- Sep 3, Indonesia:**
Pope lands in capital, **Jakarta**
- Sep 4:** Meets President **Joko Widodo**, delivers speech at Presidential Palace and meets religious leaders at **Cathedral of Our Lady of the Assumption**
- Sep 5:** Presides over interfaith meeting at **Istiqlal Mosque**, largest in Southeast Asia. Mass in **Gelora Bung Karno Stadium**
- Sep 6, Papua New Guinea:**
Arrives in capital, **Port Moresby**
- Sep 7:** Greets street children and people with disabilities
- Sep 8:** Meets Prime Minister **James Marape**, presides over Mass in **Sir John Guise Stadium**. Flies to city of **Vanimo** to greet local missionaries and address Catholics at **Holy Cross Cathedral**, before flying back to capital
- Sep 9, East Timor:** Pope arrives in capital, **Dili**
- Sep 10:** Visits children with disabilities, meets local clergy in **Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception**, and holds Mass in **Esplanade of Taci Tolu**

- Sep 11, Singapore:** Arrival
- Sep 12:** Meets Prime Minister **Lawrence Wong** before Mass in **SportsHub National Stadium**
- Sep 13:** Attends interreligious meeting with young people in **Catholic Junior College** and visits the elderly.
