▲ Following a three-year study, British scientists Richard Doll and Austin Hill published a paper confirming the link between smoking and lung cancer

1924: A protocol was adopted by the League of Nations in Geneva to resolve all international disputes by arbitration

2004: Over 1,500 migrants arrived in a single week on the tiny Italian island of Lampedusa

2008: The wreckage of a plane flown by adventurer Steve Fossett was found in mountains a year after it disappeared

2018: Saudi journalist Jamal Khashoggi was murdered inside the Saudi consulate in Istanbul
