

Trump's controversial rhetoric



■ **Sep 10. Presidential debate:** Former President **Donald Trump** repeats false claim that Democrats support abortions **“after birth”** and **“executing”** new-born babies

■ **Sep 10:** During debate with Vice President **Kamala Harris**, Trump restates baseless claim that Haitian immigrants in Ohio are eating pets. **“In Springfield, they’re eating the dogs,”** he says. **“The people that came in, they’re eating the cats”** – comments spark outrage

■ **Sep 10:** Trump insists Harris supports **“transgender operations”** on illegal aliens that are in prison

■ **Sep 20:** At **Israeli American Council (IAC)** summit in Washington, DC Trump claims that Jewish-American voters would be partly to blame if he loses election in November. He repeats assertion that Israel

would likely cease to exist within two years should Democrats win

■ **Sep 21:** Trump increases his rhetoric against immigrants who are in country legally by claiming that they are attacking U.S. **“villages and cities.”** Elsewhere in his speech he claims: **“a vote for Kamala Harris means 40 or 50 million more illegal aliens will invade across our borders, stealing your money, stealing your jobs, stealing your life”**

■ **Sep 22:** During a rally in Wilmington, North Carolina, Trump promises to occupy with federal forces so-called **“sanctuary cities”** which host undocumented immigrants
