▲ **Oscar de la Renta, Dominican-American fashion designer, died at age 82. He became famous in the 1960s as one of Jackie Kennedy's favoured couturiers**

**1947:** An investigation into Communist infiltration of Hollywood began, blacklisting people for years

**1994:** Hollywood star **Burt Lancaster**, known for both “tough guy” and more complex roles, died at age 80

**2002:** Blue Stream, the world's deepest underwater pipeline, was opened between Russia and Turkey

**2011:** Deposed Libyan leader **Muammar Gaddafi** was captured and killed by revolutionary forces
