*October 23, 1915*

▲ Over 25,000 women marched through New York City to demand the right to vote, the largest such parade yet held. American women finally won the vote in 1920

**1999:** British supermarkets withdrew French produce in protest at France's refusal to lift the ban on British beef

**2002:** Chechen rebels seized over 700 hostages at a Moscow theatre, demanding Russia withdraw from Chechnya

**2005:** Saplings of Wollemi pine, rediscovered in Australia in 1994, went on sale for the first time

**2011:** Cristina Kirchner was re-elected as President of Argentina
