▲ A patent was obtained for industrial production of the Italian sweet bread, Pandoro. Meaning Golden Bread, it was previously affordable only to the rich

1485: The Yeomen of the Guard, nicknamed "Beefeaters" because of their daily ration of beef, was founded by King Henry VII of England

1934: Italian dictator Benito Mussolini ordered all six to eight-year-olds to undertake pre-military training

1974: Muhammad Ali regained the world heavyweight boxing title by knocking out George Foreman

2022: Luiz Inácio Lula da Silva was re-elected as president of Brazil
