▲ **Veteran Palestinian leader Yasser Arafat, symbol of his people's struggle for nationhood for 40 years, died in a French military hospital at the age of 75**

1790: Chrysanthemums were introduced into England from China

1918: The First World War, which had claimed the lives of around 10 million soldiers, ended at 11am

2017: The Louvre Abu Dhabi, the first museum of its kind in the Arab world, opened

2021: China's leaders approved a landmark resolution that allowed Xi Jinping to secure an unprecedented third term as president
