▲ The RotoLactor, a rotating milking platform invented by Henry W. Jeffers that could milk 1,680 cows in seven hours, was installed at a dairy in New Jersey

1994: Swedes voted by a majority of 52.2 percent in a referendum to join the European Union

1994: A 79-year-old golfer in Massachusetts dropped dead after hitting his first ever hole-in-one

2015: Coordinated terrorist attacks targeting a concert hall, stadium and bars in Paris killed 130 people

2023: Gaza's largest hospital, Al-Shifa, "ceased to function" after running out of fuel
