About 240 million people are eligible to vote in this year's U.S. election, but just a few thousand votes in key swing states are likely to decide who becomes the next president

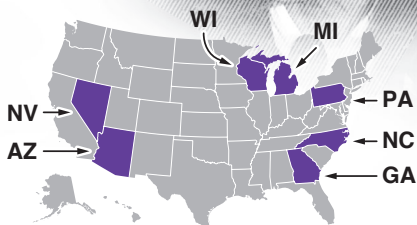
