

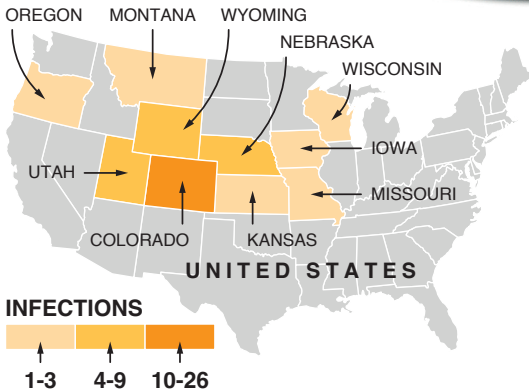
McDonald's linked to deadly bacteria

McDonald's in the U.S. is at the centre of a deadly *E. coli* outbreak, linked to its Quarter Pounder burger, which has killed one person and made dozens of other customers ill

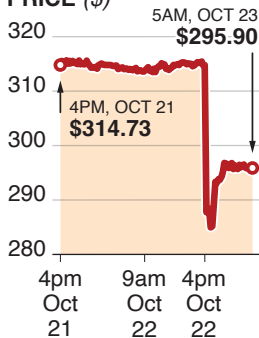
McDonald's *Quarter Pounder* burger is unavailable in some U.S. states after outbreak of *E. coli* O157:H7 variant

As of 1200GMT, Oct 23, there are 49 known infections. One older person has died and 10 others are in hospital, including child with complications from hemolytic uremic syndrome (HUS) – condition that damages blood vessels and can cause deadly clots
