STATUS **Nov 19:** Manhattan District Attorney's office asks Justice **Juan Merchan** (right) to set deadline of Dec 9 for both sides to file new motions. Options include "deferral of all remaining criminal proceedings" until end of Trump's upcoming presidential term. ***Because falsifying business records is state crime, only governor of New York can pardon Trump***

STATUS **Jul 1, 2024:** U.S. Supreme Court rules by 6-3 that former presidents have broad immunity from prosecution. ***Because charges are all federal crimes, Trump could pardon himself as president***
