

Syrian rebels enter Aleppo city

Rebel forces have reportedly entered parts of Syria's second-largest city, Aleppo, in the biggest offensive against the government in years

Nov 27: Islamist militant group *Hayat Tahrir al-Sham (HTS)* and allied factions launch offensive, seizing control of more than 50 towns and parts of Aleppo, *Syrian Observatory for Human Rights (SOHR)* reports

Nov 29: More than 20 Syrian and Russian air strikes on Aleppo city and surrounding areas reported

255 people, mostly combatants, have been killed in fighting, SOHR says
