FORMER PREMIER OF
BRITISH COLUMBIA

Some MPs see Clark as good choice because Conservatives can't tie her to nine years of Trudeau's government in Ottawa



Mélanie Joly

MINISTER

Oxford-educated lawyer, she is seasoned political organiser who recently visited Mar-a-Lago to discuss strengthening Canada-U.S. border



Anita Anand

MINISTER

Has risen up party ranks since 2019 election win. Oversaw distribution of Covid vaccines and tackled sexual harassment in armed forces
