In office	Lifespan after office	Living
Jefferson and Adams die hours apart on July 4, Independence Day , in 1826	1850: First documented use of presidential seal, based on President Millard Fillmore's sketch of eagle holding olive branch and three arrows	



First president to die in office – succumbs to pneumonia one month after being sworn in

For first time there are six living presidents*

July 2, 1881:
Shot in back by
Charles J. Guiteau
in Washington DC
railroad station.
Dies 11 weeks later

First president to lose re-election bid but later regain presidency

Sep 6, 1901: Shot twice in abdomen by **Leon Czolgosz** in Buffalo, New York. Dies eight days later. **Secret Service** ordered to protect presidents

Nov 22, 1963: Shot by *Lee Harvey Oswald* as motorcade drives through Dallas, Texas. Pronounced dead 30 minutes later

Dies in office

Only president elected more than twice – he dies one month into his fourth term following brain haemorrhage

1951: 22nd Amendment
limits president to only two four-year terms in office

Grover Cleveland
and **Donald Trump** – only presidents to lose re-election bid and later regain presidency

Second president to lose re-election bid but later regain presidency
