

Trump's key executive actions on Day One

U.S. President Donald Trump has issued a flurry of executive orders and directives within hours of taking office to fulfil some of his campaign promises



IMMIGRATION

Bar asylum for

people newly arriving at southern border

Move to end **birthright citizenship** for children of undocumented immigrants – would require overturning **14th Amendment**

Temporarily suspend **Refugee Admissions Programme**

Declare migrant crossings at U.S.-Mexico border a **national emergency**, triggering funding for border wall

Resume policy requiring people seeking asylum to **remain in Mexico** while awaiting hearings



CLIMATE AND ENERGY

Withdraw U.S. from **Paris Agreement** – designed to limit rising global temperatures

Declare **national energy emergency**, potentially unlocking new powers to suspend environmental rules and facilitate oil, gas and mining activities



JAN 6 RIOTS

Full pardons for 1,500 people involved in 2021 U.S. Capitol attack



GOVERNMENT REFORM

Freeze hiring of federal employees

End remote work policies and order federal workers back to office full time

Launch review of Biden administration over **"weaponisation"** of government against political opponents



TRADE AND TARIFFS

Direct federal agencies to review trade practices and examine flows of migrants and drugs from Canada, China and Mexico to U.S.



OTHER ACTIONS

Delay banning social media platform **TikTok** for 75 days

Withdraw from **World Health Organisation**

Rename **Mount Denali** and **Gulf of Mexico**

Launch Elon Musk-led **Department of Government Efficiency**

Recognise two sexes – male and female – and eliminate federal diversity programmes
