

# German parties address immigration

A double stabbing in Bavaria – and subsequent detention of an Afghan man – forces immigration back to the centre of the election campaign



Immigration essential in ageing society  
Family reunification to aid integration  
Rejects border closures  
Supports voluntary deportations of refused asylum seekers

Backs permanent border controls  
Increased detentions of illegal migrants  
Suspension of family reunification  
Deportations to Syria and Afghanistan



Backs common EU migration policy with controls on EU borders  
Welcomes asylum seekers and skilled migrants, with effective integration  
Criminals repatriated after sentence

Expand list of “safe” countries of origin  
Detention centres at borders and airports  
Reduce benefits for asylum seekers  
Deportation of criminals and “extremists”
