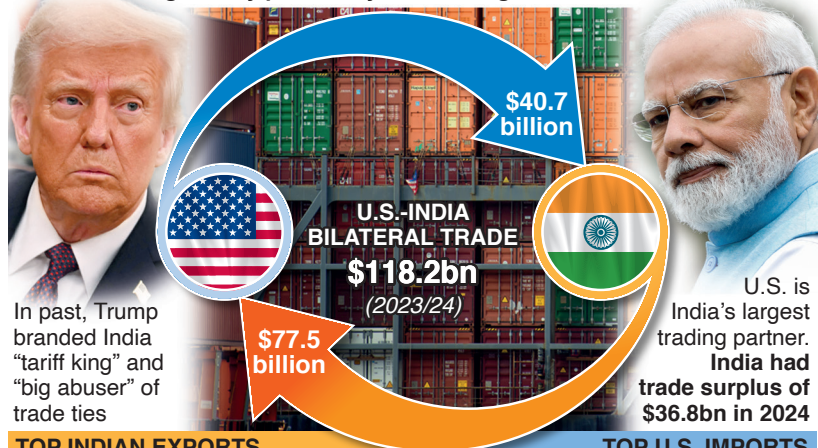


Modi to meet Trump amid tariff concerns

Prime Minister Narendra Modi's visit to Washington comes as India delivers a series of quick concessions to President Trump aimed at warding off any potentially devastating trade war with the U.S.



In past, Trump branded India "tariff king" and "big abuser" of trade ties

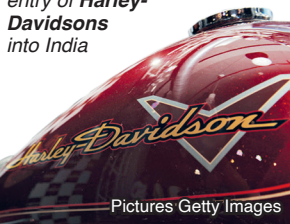

APPEASING TRUMP

TARIFF CUTS: Import duties on items such as motorcycles (**worth \$3m in U.S. exports in 2024**), satellite ground installations, synthetic flavouring essences and fish hydrolysate for aquatic feed – slashed

MIGRATION: New Delhi has pledged to accept deportation of undocumented Indian migrants in U.S. as part of Trump's immigration agenda.
U.S. has identified about 18,000 Indian nationals it believes entered illegally
