

Israel-Hamas ceasefire deal at risk

The fragile ceasefire is facing further uncertainty after Hamas said it will delay the next scheduled release of hostages in the Gaza Strip, accusing Israel of violating the six-week truce

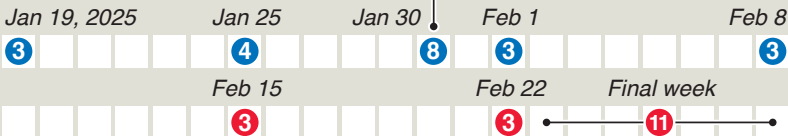

Includes five Thai hostages released under separate deal

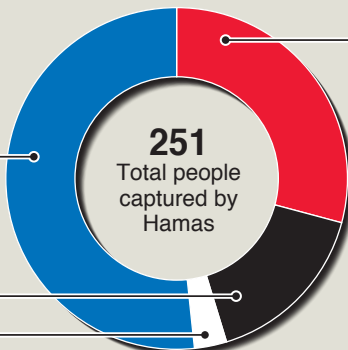


HOSTAGES TAKEN

Among those still being held are a mother and her two young sons, 13 Israeli soldiers (six believed to be alive) and five non-Israelis (two believed alive)
