

Arab leaders endorse Egyptian plan for Gaza

Egypt's five-year proposal to rebuild the Gaza Strip is seen as a counter to U.S. President Donald Trump's idea of permanently displacing Palestinians from the territory



Early recovery (6 months)

- Begin clearing rubble from main Gaza highway and other areas
- Set up temporary housing units across Gaza to take in 1.2 million displaced people
- Repair 60,000 damaged homes to accommodate 360,000 people

Reconstruction I (2 years)

- Gradually restore infrastructure such as water, electricity and telecommunications services
- Construct 200,000 permanent homes for 1.6 million people
- Rehabilitate 8,000 hectares of agricultural land

Reconstruction II (2.5 years)

- Complete infrastructure projects
- Build another 200,000 permanent homes for 1.2 million people
- Establish industrial zones, fishing port, commercial seaport and international airport

Governance

- Hamas to cede power to interim committee of political independents until reformed **Palestinian Authority** can assume control
- Supervised international trust fund would receive pledges to implement rebuilding plan
- Egypt and Jordan to assist in training Palestinian police force for deployment in Gaza
