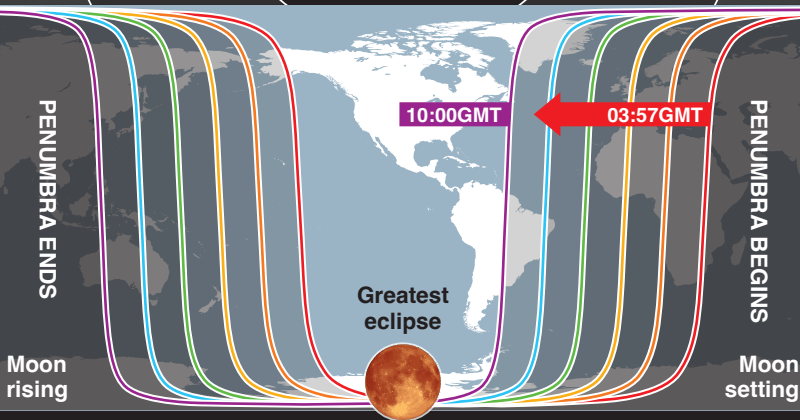
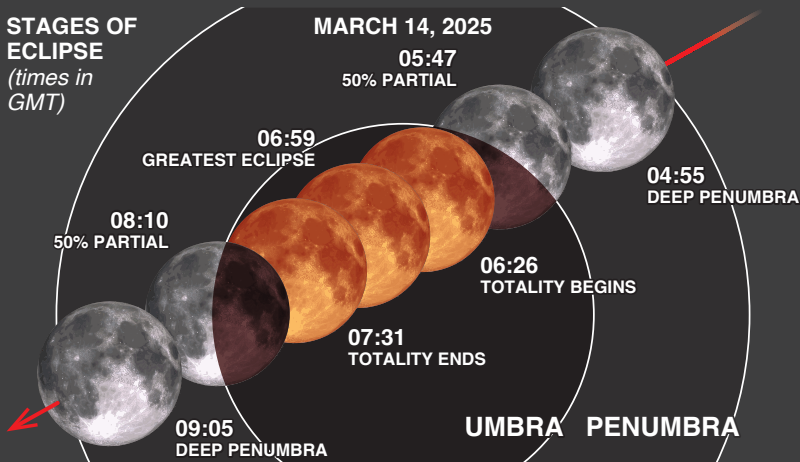


March “blood moon” lunar eclipse

On Friday, March 14, the Americas will witness a spectacular lunar eclipse – one that will turn the moon red for about an hour – the first time such an event has occurred anywhere since 2022

STAGES OF ECLIPSE

(times in GMT)



TOTAL LUNAR ECLIPSE

Earth blocks sunlight usually reflected by moon, creating partial (*penumbra*) or total (*umbra*) shadow

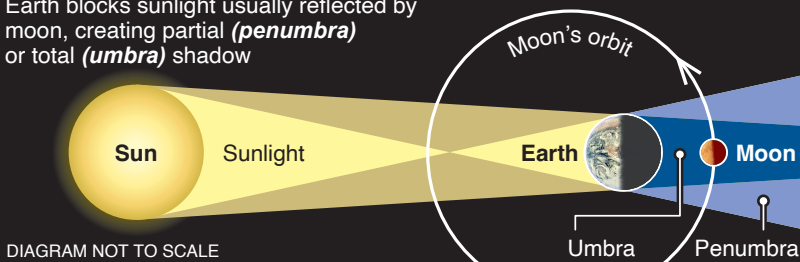


DIAGRAM NOT TO SCALE
