

Ukraine agrees to U.S. ceasefire plan

Kyiv has accepted a U.S proposal for a 30-day interim ceasefire with Russia after “milestone” talks in Jeddah, following the disastrous meeting between Presidents Trump and Zelensky at the White House in February



Interim ceasefire: Immediate 30-day truce along entire front line with possible extension by mutual agreement



Intelligence: Resumption of U.S. intelligence sharing and security assistance. ***Already restarted***



Minerals: U.S. to develop Ukraine's rare earth mineral resources. ***Agreement under discussion***
