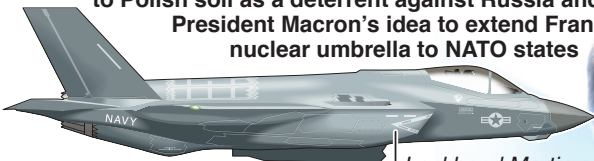


Poland urges U.S. to deploy nuclear warheads

Poland's president calls on the U.S. to transfer nuclear weapons to Polish soil as a deterrent against Russia and welcomes President Macron's idea to extend France's nuclear umbrella to NATO states

NUCLEAR-WEAPON STATE

NUCLEAR SHARING

Around **100 U.S. B61** nuclear bombs stored at six bases in five countries. Those five countries, plus Greece, practise delivering them using dual-capable aircraft*

CONVENTIONAL SUPPORT

Contribute conventionally armed aircraft to support those nuclear missions

OTHER NATO MEMBERS

Airbases storing U.S. bombs

UK: About 250 nuclear warheads
