

U.S. launches airstrikes on Yemen

The United States has vowed to continue attacks on Yemen's Houthi rebels until the Iran-backed group stops targeting military and commercial shipping in the Red Sea

RED SEA ATTACKS TIMELINE

■ **Nov 2023:** Houthis begin targeting shipping, saying they are acting in solidarity with Palestinians over Israel's war in Gaza

■ Attacks disrupt global commerce and set U.S. military off on costly campaign to intercept Houthi missiles and drones

■ **Jan 2025:** Houthis suspend attacks when Israel and Hamas agree to Gaza ceasefire

■ **Mar 11:** Houthis say they are resuming attacks on Israeli ships due to ongoing Gaza blockade

■ **Mar 15:** At least 53 people reportedly killed in first U.S. strikes on Yemen under President **Donald Trump**



■ **Mar 16:** Houthis' retaliatory attack on U.S. aircraft carrier group fails to hit any vessels
