

Sudan's army retakes presidential palace

Sudan's army recaptures the presidential palace in Khartoum and appears poised to regain control of the capital two years after it was kicked out by the rival paramilitary Rapid Support Forces



■ Rapid Support Forces (RSF) militia, led by **Mohamed Hamdan Dagalo**, known as **Hemedti** (right), took palace and most of capital at outbreak of war in Apr 2023, but Sudanese Armed Forces (SAF), led by **Abdel Fattah al-Burhan** (left), have staged a comeback in recent months
