

Aid pledged to earthquake-hit Myanmar



China: \$13.8 million pledged for quake relief. 135 search and rescue specialists, along with medical kits and drones



India: Two C-17 military aircraft with field hospital unit and 118 personnel, plus two navy ships carrying around 50 tonnes of relief material



Thailand: Country also hit by quake has sent 55 air force personnel including medics and rescue specialists



Malaysia: \$2.2 million in aid and 50-member disaster relief team



Vietnam: More than 100 rescuers and medical staff, plus \$300,000 in aid



South Korea: \$2 million through international organisations



Philippines: 114 rescue teams as well as medical assistance teams



Singapore: 80-member team to assist with rescue efforts



Russia: 120 rescuers and supplies, plus medical team



Australia: \$2 million through International Red Cross



New Zealand: \$1.14 million to Red Cross



UK: \$12.9 million pledged in aid



Ireland: \$6.5 million in aid



European Union: \$2.7 million in emergency aid. Copernicus satellite system activated to provide emergency mapping services



U.S.: Has pledged \$2 million dispersed through Myanmar-based humanitarian groups. Emergency response team from **USAID**, which is undergoing massive cuts under Trump administration, deploying to Myanmar
