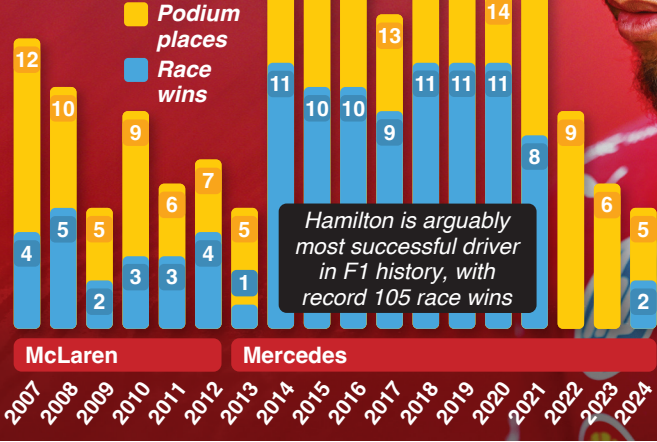


Hamilton aims for Ferrari reboot

Seven-time F1 world champion Lewis Hamilton has endured a stuttering start to his Ferrari career. Struggles with car performance, race strategy and disqualification in China, have intensified pressure on the British driver to deliver a first podium in Ferrari colours
