

# Britain announces surge in Ukraine support

The UK government has unveiled a fresh £450 million military aid package for Ukraine, as European allies attempt to strengthen Kyiv's position ahead of any peace deal with Russia

## RECENT UK MILITARY ASSISTANCE TO UKRAINE

■ **Sep 6, 2024:** 650 Lightweight Multirole Missiles (LMM) to boost Kyiv's air defences – **£162m**

■ **Dec 19:** Package includes maritime drones and small boats, air defence systems and counter-drone systems – **£225m**

■ **Jan 16, 2025:** UK and Ukraine sign 100-year partnership agreement aiming to build military, economic and cultural ties

■ **Feb 12:** Drones, tanks, armoured vehicles and air defence systems – **£150m**

■ **Feb 24:** Largest military aid package announced to date, covering total military financing for Ukraine in 2025 – **£4.5 billion**

■ **Mar 2:** Deal allows Ukraine to purchase more than 5,000 LMMs through export finance – **£1.6 billion**
