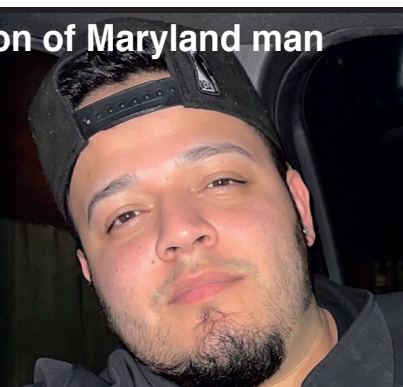


Mistaken deportation of Maryland man

A Maryland judge is demanding that President **Donald Trump's** administration return a man it admits was mistakenly deported to a mega-prison in El Salvador

■ **2011:** **Kilmar Ábrego García** (right) comes to U.S. from El Salvador illegally

■ **2019:** Immigration judge grants Kilmar legal protection from deportation on grounds that he might be at risk of gang persecution



■ **Mar 12, 2025:** Kilmar arrested in Baltimore, Maryland, by federal immigration authorities

■ **Mar 15:** Sent to El Salvador's notorious **Cecot (Terrorism Confinement Centre)**, right, along with hundreds of other men accused of being gang members

■ **Mar 24:** Kilmar's wife, **Jennifer Vasquez Sura** (below), sues Trump administration to bring him back



■ **Apr 4:** Federal judge **Paula Xinis** orders government to "facilitate and effectuate" Kilmar's return

■ **Apr 10:** U.S. Supreme Court upholds Xinis' order following challenge by Trump administration



■ **Apr 14:** Visiting Trump at White House, El Salvador's President **Nayib Bukele** (right) says he will not let Kilmar return to U.S.

■ **Apr 15:** Judge Xinis gives Trump administration two weeks to submit evidence on how it is trying to return Kilmar, warning "**there will be no tolerance for gamesmanship**"
