

U.S. pressures Kyiv to accept peace plan

President Trump's "final offer" to end the war in Ukraine proposes a freeze of the frontlines in exchange for terms that critics argue amount to a surrender to Russian interests

CONCESSIONS TO RUSSIA

President Putin

- 1 U.S. recognition of Russian control in **Crimea**
- 2 De facto recognition of Russia's occupation of nearly all of **Luhansk Oblast** and occupied territory of **Donetsk, Kherson and Zaporizhzhya**
- 3 Promise that Ukraine will not become member of **NATO**, although it could join **EU**
- 4 Lifting of sanctions imposed since 2014 and enhancement of U.S.-Russian economic cooperation

CONCESSIONS TO UKRAINE

President Zelensky

- 1 "Robust security guarantee" involving ad hoc group of European and possibly non-European nations – not clear whether U.S. would take part in "peacekeeping force"
- 2 Return of small part of **Kharkiv Oblast** Russia has occupied
- 3 Promised unimpeded passage along **Dnipro River** in south
- 4 Receive compensation and assistance for reconstruction from unspecified funding source
