

# U.S. to stop bombing Houthis

President Donald Trump says the U.S. will stop attacking the Houthis in Yemen, as Oman confirmed a “ceasefire” had been reached with the Iran-backed group for it to stop targeting shipping in the Red Sea

## RED SEA ATTACKS TIMELINE

■ **Nov 2023:** Houthis begin targeting shipping, saying they are acting in solidarity with Palestinians over Israel’s war in Gaza

■ Attacks disrupt global commerce and set U.S. military off on costly campaign to intercept Houthi missiles and drones

■ **Jan 2025:** Houthis suspend attacks when Israel and Hamas agree to Gaza ceasefire

■ **Mar 11:** Houthis say they are resuming attacks on Israeli ships due to ongoing Gaza blockade

■ **Mar 15:** At least 53 people killed in first U.S. strikes on Yemen under President Trump

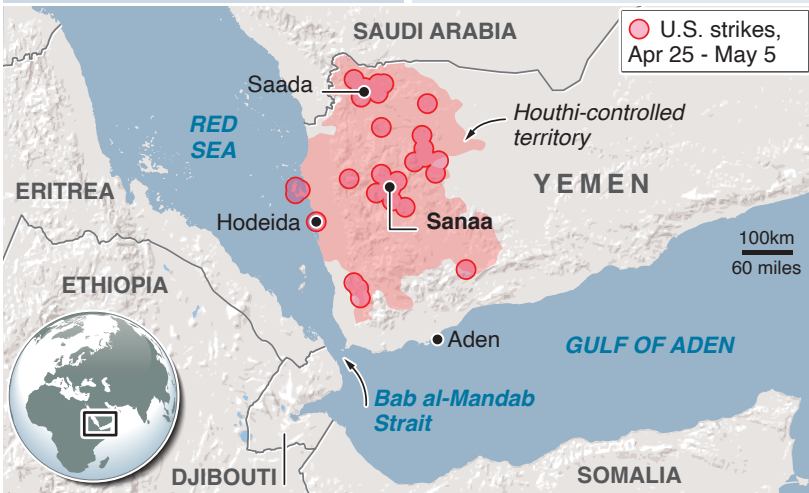
